

Our Guest Policy:

Because we are often limited in the number of attendees we can accommodate at our general meetings, social events and special interest group activities, it is important that we accommodate our members first. In view of this, there are times when we must limit the number of non-members who are invited as guests. The following paragraphs describe our revised guest policy:

1. Attendance at General Quarterly Luncheon Meetings is generally limited to UPWC members only.
2. Attendance at Social Events will be determined by the Social Chair prior to each event. Generally, social events are open to guests including husbands, friends, or house guests. If the event has limited reservations, and the Social Chair determines that guests may not be invited, this will be announced on the reservation form and event information.
3. Attendance by a guest at a special interest group, for example, attending an Out-to-Lunch, playing canasta or bridge, etc., will be permitted unless the event chair determines that guests cannot be accommodated due to limited space.
4. A UPCC resident can attend as a guest only once. After the one introductory visit, she is expected to join if she wishes to attend additional events.
5. If a member does not renew her membership she cannot come as a guest in any future year.
